ORDER BY CONSENT - 08 June 2017

In the matter of

Miss Lisa Newton (170646)

Misconduct

Miss Newton's professional conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On 08 September 2014 Miss Newton was a director of X Ltd, which was wound-up by Court Order.
2. Miss Newton failed to inform AAT that X Ltd had been wound-up within 30 days of the date of the winding-up order.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Miss Newton is hereby:

1. Removed of her fellow member status.
2. Suspended from AAT membership until the matter of X Ltd's liquidation has been concluded and there are no adverse findings by the liquidator.

Consent

Miss Newton actively agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
