ORDER BY CONSENT - 30 June 2017

In the matter of

Miss Grace Ricketts (20047989)

Misconduct

Grace Ricketts professional conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On or about the 25 July 2016, at Birmingham Magistrates Court, whilst being a student member of AAT, Grace Ricketts was convicted of theft (by employee).

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Miss Ricketts is hereby:

1. Declared unfit to become a *full* AAT member, and
2. Withdrawn from student registration for a period of 36 months from the date of the order.

Consent

Miss Ricketts has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
