**ORDER BY CONSENT**

**In the matter of**

Alicia Derby (20097290)

**Misconduct**

Alicia Derby's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On or around 14 February 2017 she was convicted at Chester Crown Court on one or more counts of possessing with the intent to supply a controlled drug of Class A whilst registered as a student member of AAT.
2. She failed to disclose one or more unspent criminal convictions to AAT within 30 days of the conviction(s) whilst registered as a student member of AAT.

**Finding**

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

**Order**

Alicia Derby is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded. The reprimand will remain live on Miss Derby's file for a period of 24 months.
- ii. Warned that she must ensure she is fully aware of – and complaint with – all guidelines, policies and regulations that govern her membership of AAT. This warning will remain active on her file for 24 months from the date the sanction is imposed by Order of the Association.

**Consent**

Alicia Derby has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
