ORDER OF AAT

In the matter of

Ausra Sajonaite (10177032)

Misconduct

Ausra Sajonaite's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between on or around 29 September 2014 and on or around 09 August 2017, whilst a full member of AAT, Mrs Sajonaite provided self-employed accountancy services to the public without being registered or licensed, or approved to provide such services whilst subject to an exemption.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Ausra Sajonaite is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded for two years.
- ii. Warned about her future conduct. The warning will remain live on Ausra Sajonaite's record for two years.
- iii. Fined £363.00.

Consent

Ausra Sajonaite is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
