ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Christopher Vickers (20191643)

Misconduct

Christopher Vickers's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between on or around 01 January 2018 until on or around 01 March 2019, he provided self-employed accountancy or related services to the public whilst not registered or licensed or approved to provide such services whilst subject to an exemption.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Christopher Vickers is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded. The reprimand will remain live on his record for a period of six months.
- ii. Fined £279.00.

Consent

Christopher Vickers has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
