ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Dhushy Thushyanthan (10039755)

Misconduct

Dhushy Thushyanthan's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On or around 15 August 2017, he was convicted of a criminal offence at North London Magistrates' Court whilst a fellow member of AAT.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Dhushy Thushyanthan is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded. The reprimand will remain live on Mr Thushyanthan's file for a period of 36 months.
- ii. Removed from fellow membership status of AAT for a period of 36 months.

Consent

Dhushy Thushyanthan has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
