**ORDER BY CONSENT**

**In the matter of**

Adine Blaeford (10296172)

**Misconduct**

Adine Blaeford's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between on or around 17 August 2012 until on or around 08 February 2019, she provided self-employed accountancy or related services to the public whilst not registered or licensed or approved to provide such services whilst subject to an exemption.

**Finding**

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

**Order**

Adine Blaeford is hereby:

- i. Fined £1,411.00
- ii. Removed from fellow membership of AAT for a period of 12 months.

**Consent**

Adine Blaeford has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
