ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Louise Letson (20013867)

Misconduct

Louise Letson's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between on or about 01 June 2016 to 20 August 2018, Louise Letson provided accountancy and/or bookkeeping services to the public without holding a licence, or approved to provide such services whilst subject to an exemption

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Louise Letson is hereby:

- i. Warned about future conduct
- ii. Fined £465

Consent

Louise Letson has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
