**ORDER BY CONSENT**

**In the matter of**

Loist Robinson (7718873)

**Misconduct**

Loist Robinson's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between on or around 19 September 2013 and on or around 30 June 2015, she was the subject of one or more County Court Judgments.

**Finding**

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

**Order**

Loist Robinson is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded, with the reprimand remaining live on her record for a period of 24 months from the date the sanction is imposed.
- ii. Advised that any future AAT licence applications received from her will be subject to a suitability assessment and are unlikely to be approved until all CCJs in her name have been satisfied.

**Consent**

Loist Robinson has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
