ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Susan Beaton (20101596)

Misconduct

Susan Beaton's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On or about 24 January 2018 Susan Beaton entered into an arrangement with her creditors while being a member of AAT

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Susan Beaton is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded, with the reprimand to remain active on her record for a period of three years from the date the sanction is imposed.
- ii. Warned with regards to future conduct

Consent

Susan Beaton has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
