ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Mr Hossein Lafafian (196601)

Misconduct

Hossein Lafafian's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On or around 28 November 2014 he was convicted of a criminal offence in West London Magistrates' Court whilst registered as an AAT member.
2. He failed to notify AAT of his criminal conviction when asked.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Hossein Lafafian is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded. The reprimand will remain live on his file for a period of 60 months.

Consent

Hossein Lafafian has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
