ORDER OF AAT

In the matter of

Katie Ward (10158409)

Misconduct

Katie Ward's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. She failed to comply with an Order made by AAT on 16 May 2017 by not providing information requested within 30 days of the Order coming into effect.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Katie Ward is expelled from membership.

Consent

Katie Ward is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
