ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of Kefalotse Pilatwe, 2024907

Misconduct Kefalotse Pilatwe's conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public and/or undermine public confidence in the Association and its members as follows:

1. On 17 September 2019, Kefalotse Pilatwe completed a computer-based assessment outside of examination conditions as prescribed by the AAT.

Finding Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for the exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order Kefalotse Pilatwe is hereby:

1. Reprimanded; the reprimand will expire 36 months from the date of this Order
2. Warned that another breach of AAT's *Code of Professional Ethics* whilst the reprimand is in force may likely result in his expulsion from the Association.

Consent Kefalotse Pilatwe passively consented to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
