ORDER OF AAT

In the matter of

Matthew Clipstone (266998)

Misconduct

Matthew Clipstone's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. For an unknown period until on or around 26 November 2014, he acted in a dishonest manner that led to him being convicted in the Northampton Crown Court for an offence involving theft.
2. For an unknown period until on or around 26 November 2014, he acted in a dishonest manner that led to him being convicted in the Northampton Crown Court for an offence involving fraud.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Matthew Clipstone is hereby expelled from membership indefinitely.

Consent

Matthew Clipstone is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
