ORDER OF AAT

In the matter of

Mr Lee Murphy (10355591)

Misconduct

Lee Murphy's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between on or around 22 May 2015 and 05 May 2017, whilst a full member of AAT, Mr Murphy provided self-employed accountancy services to the public without being registered or licensed, or approved by AAT as being the subject of an exemption.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Lee Murphy is hereby:

- i. reprimanded
- ii. warned about his future conduct
- iii. fined £363.00.

The sanctions above will remain live on Mr Murphy's record for two years.

Consent

Lee Murphy has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
