**ORDER BY CONSENT**

**In the matter of**

Neil Clegg (7636)

**Misconduct**

Neil Clegg's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On or around 04 May 2017 he was convicted of a criminal offence at Avon & Somerset Magistrates' Court whilst registered as a fellow member of AAT.

**Finding**

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

**Order**

Neil Clegg is hereby:

- i. Expelled from membership of AAT until such time as his conviction becomes spent.
- ii. Subject to a suitability assessment should he reapply for membership of AAT after his conviction has become spent.

**Consent**

Neil Clegg is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
