#### ORDER OF AAT

<b>In the matter of</b>	Nathan Wilkins (20109840)
<b>Misconduct</b>	<p>Nathan Wilkins' professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the <i>Code of Professional Ethics</i> and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. On 14 December 2016, whilst a member, Mr Wilkins was upon his own confession, convicted on indictment of theft by employee and false accounting in the Crown Court at Cambridge.</li></ol>
<b>Finding</b>	Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the <i>Disciplinary Regulations</i> .
<b>Order</b>	<p>Nathan Wilkins is hereby:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. expelled indefinitely</li><li>ii. declared unfit to become a full member indefinitely.</li></ol>
<b>Consent</b>	<p>Nathan Wilkins is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the <i>Disciplinary Regulations</i>.</p> <p>06 September 2017</p>
