ORDER OF AAT

In the matter of

Mr Robert Picken (7903414)

Misconduct

Robert Picken's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between on or around 1 January 2010 and 31 October 2016, Mr Picken provided accountancy services to the public as Robert Picken whilst not registered or licensed to do so, or approved by AAT as being the subject of an exemption.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Robert Picken is hereby:

- i. reprimanded
- ii. fined £1119.00.

Consent

Robert Picken has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
