ORDER OF AAT

In the matter of

Stella Ogun, 182476

Misconduct

Stella Ogun's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On 30 December 2013, she entered into an Individual Voluntary Arrangement whilst a fellow member.
2. She did not notify AAT of her Individual Voluntary Arrangement within 30 days of the date of its occurrence, in accordance with AAT's *Insolvency Policy*.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

The following sanctions have been imposed against Stella Ogun:

- i. her fellow member status has been removed for a period of three years
- ii. she has been warned over her future conduct.

Consent

Stella Ogun agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
