ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Mr Shkumbin Bileri, 20131926

Misconduct

Shkumbin Bileri's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between on or about 18 April 2016 until 15 November 2018 Shkumbin Bileri failed to have in place appropriate professional indemnity insurance whilst providing self-employed accountancy or related services to the public

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Shkumbin Bileri is hereby:

- i. Warned with regards to future conduct.
- ii. Fined £350.

Consent

Shkumbin Bileri actively agreed to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
