ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Alison Beatty (176342)

Misconduct

Alison Beatty's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between on or around 10 June 2011 and on or around 10 August 2021, she provided self-employed accountancy or related services to the public whilst not registered or licensed or approved to provide such services whilst subject to an exemption.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Alison Beatty is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded, with the reprimand to remain live on her record for a period of two years/24 months.
- ii. Fined £1,509.00.

Consent

Alison Beatty has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
