**ORDER BY CONSENT**

**In the matter of**

Alison Berry (287489)

**Misconduct**

Alison Berry's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. Between an unknown date and on or around 16 December 2020, she provided services outside the scope of her AAT licence; namely:
  - a. financial accounts and accounts preparation for sole traders and partnerships; and/or
  - b. business income tax.

**Finding**

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

**Order**

Alison Berry is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded. The reprimand is to remain live on her record for a period of 12 months from the date of this order.

**Consent**

Alison Berry is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
