ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Brian Meredith (6029159)

Misconduct

Brian Meredith's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On an unspecified date, he disclosed confidential information to a third party without client consent.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Brian Meredith is hereby:

- i. Warned that he must take adequate measures to ensure client confidentiality is not breached in the future including – but not limited to – seeking legal advice or advice from his professional body where appropriate.

Consent

Brian Meredith has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
