**ORDER OF AAT**

**In the matter of**

Chahir Maizi (260884)

**Misconduct**

Chahir Maizi's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On or around 05 February 2019, he was upon his own admission convicted of possession with intent to supply a class B drug at Hove Crown Court.
2. He failed to disclose his criminal conviction to AAT within 30 days, as required by AAT's *Criminal Convictions* policy.

**Finding**

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

**Order**

Chahir Maizi is hereby:

- i. Expelled from the Association for a period of five years.

**Consent**

Chahir Maizi is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
