ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Colin Sage FMAAT, 153591

Misconduct

Colin Sage's conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public and/or undermine public confidence in the Association and its members as follows:

1. On 09 July 2020, Colin Sage was convicted of an indictable offence at Chelmsford Crown Court whilst registered as an AAT fellow member.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for the exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Colin Sage is hereby:

1. Divested of his fellow member status.
2. Expelled from membership of AAT for a period of four years.

Consent

Colin Sage actively consented to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
