ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of Gabriella Huszar 10433236

Misconduct Gabriella Huszar's conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public and/or undermine public confidence in the Association and its members as follows:

1. Between on or around 01 November 2018 and on or around 25 September 2020, she provided Personal Income Tax services and Business Income Tax services to clients outside of the scope of her bookkeeping licence whilst not qualified or regulated to do so.

Finding Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for the exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Gabriella Huszar is hereby:

1. Reprimanded; the reprimand will expire two years from the date of this Order
2. Warned about her future conduct

Consent

Gabriella Huszar consented to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
