ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Gemma Fosbrook (20074369)

Misconduct

Gemma Fosbrook's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. On or around 05 March 2021, she was convicted of 12 counts of theft in Worcester Crown Court in respect of actions undertaken by her whilst she was a member of AAT.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Gemma Fosbrook is hereby:

- i. Expelled from membership of AAT for an indefinite period of time.

Consent

Gemma Fosbrook is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
