ORDER OF AAT

In the matter of

Kevin James (263778)

Misconduct

Kevin James' professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. For an unknown period up until on or around 18 February 2020, whilst a full member of AAT, he provided self-employed accountancy services to the public without being registered or licensed to do so or approved as being exempt from holding a licence.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under paragraphs 6 and 31 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Kevin James is hereby:

- i. Expelled for a period of three years.

Consent

Kevin James is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
