ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Lee Murphy MAAT, 10355591

Misconduct

Lee Murphy's conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public and/or undermine public confidence in the Association and its members as follows:

1. Between on or around 01 July 2019 until on or around 12 March 2020, Lee Murphy provided self-employed accountancy or related services to the public whilst not licensed or approved to provide such services whilst subject to an exemption.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for the exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Lee Murphy is hereby:

1. Reprimanded; the reprimand will expire three years from the date of this Order
2. Fined £750
3. Warned about this future conduct.

Consent

Lee Murphy consented to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
