## **ORDER BY CONSENT**

In the matter of

Mr Neil Barrett MAAT, 97055

**Misconduct** 

Mr Neil Barrett's professional or personal conduct, was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

 Between on or around 23 October 2009 and on or around 01 October 2020, Mr Neil Barrett provided self-employed accountancy and or bookkeeping and/or related services to the public without being registered or licensed, or approved to provide such services whilst subject to an exemption.

**Finding** 

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

The following sanctions have been imposed

- Reprimand, with the reprimand remaining live on his records for a period of 24 months.
- ii. Warning about his future conduct.
- iii. Fine of £2,436.00

Consent

Mr Barrett has agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
