ORDER BY CONSENT

In the matter of

Sallyann Pigram (275941)

Misconduct

Sallyann Pigram's professional or personal conduct was found to be in breach of the *Code of Professional Ethics* and to have posed a risk to the public or was likely to undermine public confidence in the Association or its members; namely:

1. From an unknown date in 2018 until on or around 04 May 2021, she provided self-employed accountancy or related services to the public whilst not licensed to provide such services or approved as exempt from holding a licence to provide such services.

Finding

Grounds for disciplinary action existed and the matter was suitable for exercise of the Investigations Team's powers under the *Disciplinary Regulations*.

Order

Sallyann Pigram is hereby:

- i. Reprimanded. The reprimand is to remain live on her record for a period of two years/24 months.
- ii. Fined £893.00.

Consent

Sallyann Pigram is deemed to have agreed to submit to the decision of the Investigations Team in accordance with Regulation 6 of the *Disciplinary Regulations*.
